Foreword

Competitive procedures such as competitions and study commissions enable the evaluation of multiple solutions that best meet architectural, social, design, technical, environmental and economic requirements (Baukultur). They guarantee the comprehensive implementation of sustainability principles.

Study commissions based on regulation SIA 143 are used when dialogue between the jury and participating teams is required. In such cases, they constitute an appropriate form of procurement for all services in the field of architecture and other planning/design disciplines relevant to Baukultur. Not all general conditions are determined conclusively in advance. Clarifications and additions to the terms of the brief can still be made during the interim discussions. All those participating in study commissions deliver high-quality intellectual work, for which lump sum compensation is paid. They are entitled to expect a fair procedure and evaluation by an expert jury. Regulation SIA 143 sets out the rules to this end.
